

Housing Process

Anyone may apply but must first be accepted to the college and enrolled as a full-time student to be eligible to reside in the Residence Halls.

A non-refundable application fee of \$100.00 for fall/spring, or \$50.00 for summer, must be submitted with the online Housing Application or it will not be accepted for processing.

Housing Checklist

- Admissions Application

- Housing Application & Pay Application Fee
 - By June 30th for Fall Term
 - By November 30th for Spring Term
- Complete FAFSA & Financial Aid Forms
- Receive Financial Aid Award Letter
- Sign & Return Award Acceptance Form
- Enroll & Register for Classes
 - Minimum of 12 credit hours for Fall and Spring; 9 of these hours MUST be seated.
 - Minimum of 6 hours for Summer
- Review Supply List & Housing Handbook
- Pay Required Residence Hall Rent In-Full at or before Move-In
- Sign & Submit Housing Contract

Brewton Campus

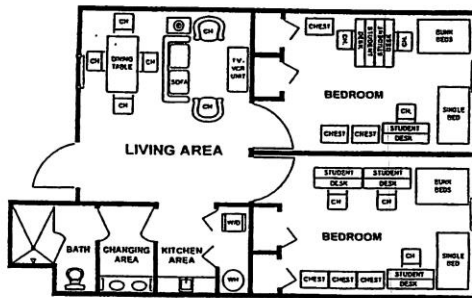

Magnolia Suite

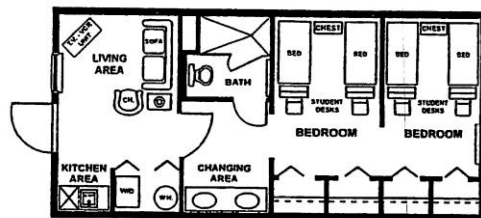
Our largest units are designed for occupancy up to four people and consist of two large bedrooms, each of which has two beds, study/storage units, and spacious closets.

Resident Assistants

Resident Assistants, or “RAs,” are full-time students who live with the residents of a particular floor. Safety at Lakeview

The property is located behind a locked gate, opened only by a key card issued to each resident. Additionally, the College contracts with a security service to provide security personnel for Lakeview.
