

Residence Hall Supply List

When moving into your room you may need the following items.
Each room is supplied with a desk, wardrobe/closet, drawers, and a chair per student.

Linens Needed:

- Mattress Cover
- Standard Single Bed Sheets (deep pocket works best)
- Pillow
- Blanket
- Comforter/Cover
- Bath Towels
- Bath Cloths
- Bath Mat

Other Suggested Items:

- Bath Soap, Shampoo, Etc.
- Laundry Detergent
- Toilet Paper
- Non-Abrasive Bathroom Cleaning Supplies
- Non-Adhesive Shelf Paper for Drawers
- Eating Utensils, Plates, Bowls, Cups
- Trash Can/Liners
- Paper Towels
- Tape/Scissors/Stapler and other study/classroom materials

Small Appliances:

- Hair Styling (i.e. Dryer)
- Television
- Small Refrigerator (4.5 cubic feet or smaller)
 - o 30" height fits under the bed
- Small microwave (1.5 cubic feet or smaller)
- 6 ft cable cord for TV Connection
- 6 ft Ethernet Cable for Computer
- Radio/Stereo and Headphones
- Small Vacuum Cleaner
- Iron/Ironing Board
- Computer/Laptop/Printer
- Small crock pots
- Keurig's are now allowed in the dorm rooms – NOT COFFEE POTS*

Prohibited Items:

- Smoking/Tobacco Products
The Residence Halls are Smoke Free Facilities, This Includes Electronic Cigarettes.
- Fireworks
- Ammunition
- Firearms (Including Pellet Guns, Air Rifles, Paintball, Guns or Air Soft-type guns)
- Incendiary, any Type of Explosive Device or Material
- Candles, Incense or Other Flame-Emitting Articles
- Signs: College Property or State, Federal, Local or Miscellaneous Signs Illegally Obtained.
- Pets
- Weight-Lifting Equipment
- Dart Boards, Darts, or Any Type of Throwing Knives
- Hunting Knives, Including Collectable or Decorative Weapons.
- Alcohol/Illegal Substances or any Alcohol/Illegal Substance Paraphernalia (Includes, But Not Limited To Bottles, Posters, Signs, and Specialty Items)
- Mattresses, Including Waterbeds
- Appliances: Coffee Makers, Toasters, Air Fryers, Toaster Ovens, Hotplates, Grills of any type, Electric Skillets, Space Heaters
- Window Fan/Air Conditioner Units
- Individual Generators
- Duct Tape
- Nails/Screws (There is a Bulletin Board Provided Where Pushpins and Tacks Can Be Used)
- Hammocks or Ceiling Hanging Chairs
- Any other items that may be listed in the current contract or in the current college catalog.
